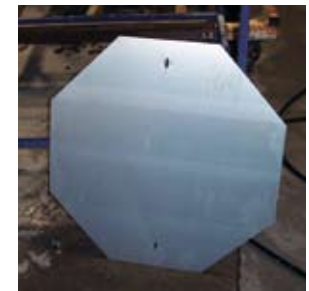
## TURN OLD SIGNS INTO NEW SIGNS WITH THE HYDROSTRIPPER

By utilizing waterjet technology, the hydrostripping process applies an ultra high-pressure water stream that removes worn out reflective sheeting from old signs without damaging the corrosion-resistant coatings on the metal.

New reflective sheeting materials are applied, providing motorists more notice and increased safety.
